Perhaps unnecessarily, we would bring to your attention that the implantation of the chip by a veterinary or other competent person will be fully for your risk. This means that the FPS cannot be held liable in the event the chip number gets lost.

You can return the protocol (including the chip number assigned to the relevant horse) to the FPS. We will register the chip number and, against payment, issue a passport if desired.
